BRAND NEW NORTH KELLYVILLE PUBLIC SCHOOL SET TO OPEN

Member for Castle Hill Ray Williams has visited the new North Kellyville Public School that will open its doors to students and teachers for the first time next week.

Stage 1 of the \$44 million project includes 20 brand new classrooms, a new hall, library, covered outdoor learning spaces, and a range of play and sporting facilities.

All classrooms will be air conditioned as part of the NSW Government's \$500 million Cooler Classrooms program that is seeing air conditioning delivered in thousands of classrooms across the State.

Mr Williams said he was thrilled that the NSW Liberals & Nationals Government was delivering a new school for the growing local community.

"This is a fantastic new school that will provide the very best educational environment for students to thrive and succeed," Mr Williams said.

Works will be continuing on the second stage of the project to provide additional classrooms to enable the school to accommodate up to 1000 students.

"The NSW Liberals & Nationals are providing facilities that allow students to achieve their best whilst at school. When they were last in power Labor shut 90 schools and left the others to fall into disrepair. It is only the NSW Liberals & Nationals that are able to deliver for public education in NSW," Mr Williams said.

Education Minister Rob Stokes said North Kellyville Public School is one of 17 new and upgraded schools opening across NSW on the first day of term.

"We are making the largest investment in public school infrastructure by any State Government in Australian history. This includes building new schools and upgrading existing facilities to enhance the educational environment for students across NSW," Mr Stokes said.

"It is only thanks to the strong economic management of our Liberals & Nationals Government that we have been able to deliver new and upgraded schools for communities around NSW," Mr Stokes said.
